**DIVERSION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC  
MOORES HILL, TATENHILL**

**NOTICE** is hereby given that the Staffordshire County Council on 20 December 2018 made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in that length of Moores Hill in Tatenhill from its junction with Main Street to its junction with Cuckoo Cage Lane unless the vehicle is being used in connection with the works. Access to frontages only, no thoroughfare. Access for pedestrians will remain open at all times.

An alternative route for traffic is available via Main Street, Postern Road, B5017 Burton Road, Needwood Road, Church Road, Tatenhill Lane, Tatenhill Common, Moores Hill and vice versa. For more information, visit: <https://roadworks.org?tm=109530055>.

**The order will come into operation on 2 January 2019 and the said works will commence on or as near as practicable to that date. It is anticipated that the works will be completed by 6 January 2019.**

The Order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the new water connections work, which it is proposed to carry out on or near the road have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
